	<u>Deed</u> copy to provide proof of ownership and property boundaries.			
	Preliminary Plat : Please refer to Appendix A of the UDO (pg. A-11) for detail requirements.			
	<u>Written narrative</u> : It is the responsibility of the applicant to demonstrate compliance with UDO §2.19 and §2.20 .			
	<u>Additional documentation</u> : Additional text and/or maps provided to demonstrate consistency with the criteria for approval of a preliminary plat listed in UDO §2.20.5(G) . The list of criteria is attached.			
	Covenants and Restrictions, if applicable.			
	<u>Utility letters</u> confirming the availability of service and improvements necessary to provide water, wastewater, natural gas or telecommunications services (not needed for Town services).			
	<u>Drainage concept plan</u> , if applicable – see drainage impact analysis checklist.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL:

- 1. <u>Staff Review</u>: Planning staff will review the application within five business days and notify the applicant if additional materials are needed.
- <u>Public Hearing</u>: A public hearing will be held before the Town Council at its regular monthly meeting. (Please refer to the <u>Application Processing Timeline</u> to determine the hearing date.) In addition to the regular meeting, the applicant or a representative is expected to attend the Town Council agenda meeting the Wednesday prior to the regular meeting.
- 3. <u>Approval</u>: The Town Council may approve, conditionally approve or deny the application based on the criteria listed in **UDO §2.20.5(G)**. The Conditional Use Permit shall not become effective until the Planning Director approves and the Applicant records the final plat for the applicable area.

UDO §2.20.5 Preliminary Plat

- (G) Criteria
 - (1) The application is consistent with the approved Sketch Plat, if applicable.
 - (2) The application is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan, as well as any other adopted plans for streets, alleys, parks, playgrounds, and public utility facilities;
 - (3) The proposed subdivision complies with the UDO and the applicable state and federal regulations;
 - (4) The proposed subdivision, including its Lot sizes, density, access, and circulation, is compatible with the existing and/or permissible zoning and future land use of adjacent property;
 - (5) The proposed subdivision will not have detrimental impacts on the safety or viability of permitted uses on adjacent properties; and
 - (6) The proposed public facilities are adequate to serve the normal and emergency demands of the proposed Development, and to provide for the efficient and timely extension to serve future Development.
