Did you know that scalding incidents are the #1 cause for burn injuries among kids? Follow these simple measures from our Fire Department to make your home safer for everyone.

- Turn pot handles to the back of the stove. Use pan lids to prevent grease splatter.
- Set a 3-foot "no kid zone" in front of appliances like stoves and heaters.
- Use microwave-safe cookware that allows steam to escape. Let food rest before removing it from the microwave.
- Test bath water for both little ones and elderly adults. Set your water heater at 120 degrees F or less.
- When young kids are present, avoid using tablecloths and also keep hot foods and drinks in the center of the table.
