Sewer Problems? Call Us First!



Do you hear gurgling water when you flush the toilet or run the dishwasher or washer? Have sewage coming from the cleanout in your yard? Those are all symptoms of a sewer backup and we're here to help. Make TOSP your first call! Our utilities crew will come out ASAP and help diagnose the problem and the next steps. If you call a plumber first, the Town is unable to troubleshoot or verify liability and will not reimburse any bills.

May is **Water Safety Month** and SPFD shares these tips.

- Drowning is a leading cause of injury-related death among children 19 and under.
- Children less than a year old are more likely to drown at home in the bathtub or a bucket.
- Watch kids without distraction and keep them within arm's reach. It only takes 1" of water for a child to drown.
- Empty tubs, buckets, containers, and kids' pools immediately after use. Store them upside down and out of reach from kids.
- Keep toilet lids down and close doors to bathrooms and laundry rooms.
- Install fences that are 4' or taller around all sides of a pool. Use self-closing and self-latching gates.
- Learn CPR and basic water rescue skills so you can quickly respond in an emergency without putting yourself at risk.
