Follow these tips from SPFD to stay safe during all of your activities this spooky season!

- When choosing a costume, stay away from long trailing fabric. If you or your child are wearing a mask, make sure the eye holes are large enough to see out.
- Provide children with flashlights or glow sticks to carry for lighting as part of their costume.
- Keep decorations away from open flames and other heat sources like light bulbs and heaters. Use extra caution with dried flowers, cornstalks, and crepe paper, which catch fire easily.
- Use a battery-operated candle or glow stick to light jack-o-lanterns. If using a real candle, use caution and keep the lit pumpkin away from doorsteps, walkways, and yards.
- Keep exits clear of decorations, so nothing blocks escape routes.
- Make sure all smoke alarms in the home are working.
- Teach children to stay away from open flames including jack-o-lanterns with candles in them. Be sure they know how to stop, drop and roll if their clothing catches fire.
