September is National Preparedness Month, and SPFD has some tips to make sure you and your family are prepared for disasters and emergencies.

- **Stay alert:** Know which types of disasters could affect our area. Sign up for alerts and warnings. In an event of an emergency, the Town of Southern Pines issues alerts through CodeRED, a high-speed notification system.
- **Make a plan:** Consider any special needs your family might have. Have a family communication plan in place to know how you'll contact one another and reconnect if separated. Make sure your kids know important phone numbers. Learn evacuation routes.
- **Build an emergency kit:** An emergency kit should have everything you need to survive for several days. Keep your kit stocked with non-perishable food and water, flashlights, radios, extra batteries, and a first aid kit. Don't forget to consider unique needs of your family including older adults and those with disabilities.
- **Don't forget your pet:** Add items to your emergency kit in case you need to evacuate with your four-legged family members. Items in your kit should include a selfie with them in case you get separated, medicine and grooming items, and a leash and collar with ID.
