SPPD encourages you to enjoy your social time safely! Whether you're shopping, enjoying dinner with a special someone, or just enjoying an evening out, these safety tips can help you avoid falling victim to crimes of opportunity!

### Shopping Tips

- Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
- Park in areas where the lighting is adequate.
- Shop with family or friends when possible.
- Conceal cash, don't flash it, and use cards if possible.
- Hide packages in the trunk or back of your vehicle.
- LOCK your vehicle doors while shopping.

### Dinner on the Town

- Choose a safe place to park near the restaurant. Walk to and from your car with others.
- Check your bill for accuracy. Fill in all blanks on credit card receipts.
- Hand deliver cash tip to wait staff.
- Collect all personal items before leaving.

### Social Time

- Never go to a bar alone & have a buddy for safety.
- Be aware of your alcohol consumption.
- Never take a drink from someone you don't know & trust.
- Have a ride. Never drink and drive.

### At Home

- Going out of town? Place your home on the residence check list
- Be sure to set your alarm
- Don't share your travel plans on social media until you've returned home.
- Pause deliveries (mail & packages, newspaper, etc.)

## FALL IN LOVE WITH THESE VALENTINE'S DAY SAFETY TIPS FROM SPFD

- Keep candles at least 12 inches from anything that can burn including curtains, clothing, and home décor.
- Keep candles on an uncluttered surface that's out of reach from pets and children.
- Blow out candles before going to sleep or leaving the room.
- When cooking, make sure frozen foods are fully defrosted before adding to hot oil.
- Keep an eye on the stove or oven while you are cooking. If you leave the room, turn off the stove.
- Set a timer to remind yourself that you are cooking.
- Keep balloons indoors. The outer coating of a balloon conducts electricity and can cause power outages if it hits electrical lines outside.
- Tie weights to balloons to keep them from floating away and do not release balloons outside.
