- Make sure that someone in your group has a cell phone in case of emergency.
- While at the pool, park, or lake, secure your valuables and never leave them unattended.
- Be mindful of the heat. Stay hydrated and take breaks to go inside.
- While out having fun, be aware of your surroundings. Be mindful of people and hazards.


Baby, You're a Firework!

This 4th of July, SPFD is reminding you to let those colors burn...in the hands of trained professionals.

In 2022, fireworks were involved with an estimated 10,200 injuries treated in U.S. hospital emergency departments and resulted in 11 deaths. They are also responsible for causing an estimated 19,500 fires in the US each year.

Keep in mind that fireworks in North Carolina are also illegal to sell, possess, and use.

Prioritize safety this year, and celebrate by watching sanctioned, public fireworks displays. We wish you a safe and happy 4th!
