- Make sure to secure all doors and windows to your home and vehicles.
- Consider purchasing a security system that has cameras and an alarm. Remember to set the alarm before you leave!
- Use timers and select lighting in your home to come on and go off at various times to give the appearance that you're home.
- If someone is entering your home, ask them to open and close window blinds or curtains.
- Inform a family member or trusted friend that you will be away. Ask them to check on your home while you're vacationing.
- Have someone collect your mail and newspapers. Or, suspend the deliveries of these items while away.
- Make sure that someone has a way to contact you in case of emergency.
- Consider placing your residence on the Police Department's "Out of Town" watch list -- call the Southern Pines Police Department at 910-692-7031.



The full sized basketball court will be an amazing addition to the park and includes a player-friendly surface, regulation height hoops, and lights. Dream Courts are an initiative of Lieberman's foundation and are centered on democratizing access to basketball for girls and boys, offering them an affordable avenue for recreation, a secure space to engage in play, an opportunity to foster social interactions, and a platform to cultivate essential values of teamwork and sportsmanship.
