Be Prepared

September is National Preparedness Month. Follow these tips from SPFD to make sure you are ready in the event of an emergency:

- **Be Informed:** Receive emergency notifications anywhere by signing up for CodeRed. Choose to receive phone, text, or email messages - or all three. Text "sopines" to 99411 to sign up.



- **Make a Plan:** Your family may not be together when disaster hits. Form an emergency plan now to navigate safely during emergency situations. Plans should include evacuation routes, a communication plan, and addressing special needs of children, pets, and elderly family members.



- **Build an Emergency Kit:** Make sure your family has enough food, water, and supplies to last three to seven days per person and pet. Include important documents, battery powered radio, cell phone chargers/portable battery pack, prescription medications, extra house/car keys, and a flashlight.
