Stand By Your Pan and Prevent Cooking Fires This Thanksgiving

SPFD reminds you to follow these tips for cooking safety this holiday season:



- Keep an eye on what you fry. If you leave the kitchen, turn the burner off.
- Supervise children and pets. Keep children and pets away from the stove to prevent burns and fires.
- If there's an oven fire, do not open the oven! Turn off the oven and keep the door closed until it is cool.
- Turn pot handles toward the back of the stove. This keeps people from bumping them or pulling them over.
- Only use a turkey fryer outdoors. Make sure the fryer is on a sturdy surface, away from things that can burn. Never try to fry a frozen turkey.
