

Recycling Service Effective January 1

More than 960 residents and small businesses have already signed up for the recycling subscription service. Their new blue-lid recycling carts will be delivered later this month.

It is not too late to subscribe - you can do that anytime - but if you want recycling to be picked up the first two weeks of January, time is running out. A few dates and facts to know:



Wednesday, Dec 18 - new carts will start being delivered.



Saturday, January 4 - the first day of recycling pick up for A Schedule in the new carts (blue lid for recycle). B Schedule first pick up Friday, Jan 10.

- Glass collection returns in 2025
- Pick up is EVERY-OTHER-WEEK
- All recyclables must be in the provided carts
- Carts must be out by 6am on the collection day

Carbon Monoxide Safety

Carbon monoxide is an invisible, odorless, colorless gas created when fuels burn incompletely. A person can be poisoned by a small amount of CO over a long period of time or a large amount of CO in a short period of time. Carbon monoxide incidents are more common in the winter months. Follow these tips from SPFD to keep you and your family safe this season:

- CO alarms should be installed in a central location outside of each sleeping area on every level of the home.
- Test CO alarms at least once a month.
- If the CO alarm sounds, immediately move to a fresh air location outdoors or by an open window or door. Make sure everyone in the home is accounted for. Call for help from a fresh air location and do not re-enter the home until emergency personnel declare that it is safe.
- If you need to warm your vehicle, remove it from the garage immediately after starting it. Do not run a vehicle or other fueled engine indoors, even if the garage doors are open. Make sure exhaust pipes are not covered in snow.
- During and after a snowstorm, make sure vents for the dryer, furnace, stove, and fireplace are clear of snow build-up.
- Generators should be used in a well-ventilated location outdoors away from windows, doors, and vent openings.
- Only use gas or charcoal grills outside.
- Have all fuel-burning heating equipment and chimneys inspected by a professional every year before cold weather sets in.
- Never use the oven to heat your home.

A New Year's Resolution - Safety Checkup

The first of a new year is a great time to update old information for your valuables. The following are tips and reminders from the Southern Pines Police Department.

- Have you updated your valuables list with serial numbers from all the new gifts you received from Christmas?
- Have you secured your old and new items in safe locations to prevent theft?
- Is it time to update your property's security features like lighting, security cameras or door locks?
- Do you have a plan to check the security of your property on a regular basis?
- Do you have a list of emergency numbers, 911, emergency contacts, etc.?
- Did you know that the Police Department will check your residence while you're out of town? Call the Police at 910-692-7031 before leaving town to request this service.
