## Emergency Notifications

We use CodeRED to send targeted alerts for road closures, utility work, solid waste schedule changes, emergencies, & more.

These messages are sent directly to affected residents—but only if you are registered. You can choose how you'd like to receive alerts: phone call, text, email—or all three.

We regularly post updates on the Town's Facebook page; follow us to see all of our latest news. During emergency situations, the Town's main Facebook page will share all major updates.

The Southern Pines Fire Department also provides critical information via social media during emergencies & events.

For non-emergency notifications—such as program updates, policy changes, or community news—sign up for NotifyMe at [sopinesnc.info/notify](https://sopinesnc.info/notify).

Unlike CodeRED, NotifyMe messages are usually not time-sensitive. You can customize your preferences to receive updates only on topics important to you.
