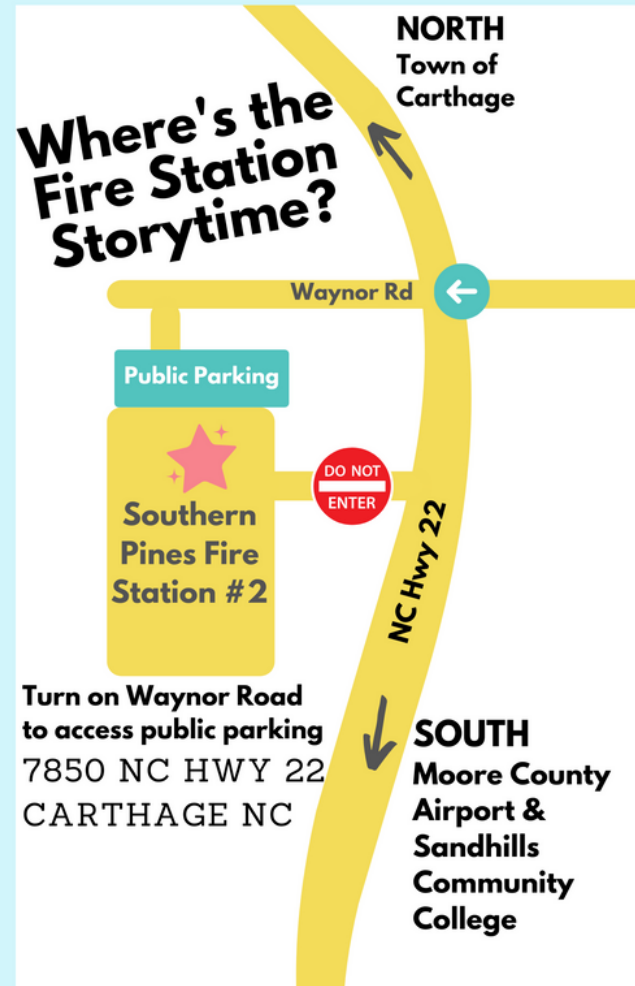
September programs will be held outside with the exception of those marked with an **

This storytime is designed for our youngest patrons and their caregivers (birth-2). Repetition and comforting movements make this story time perfect for early development and growth.



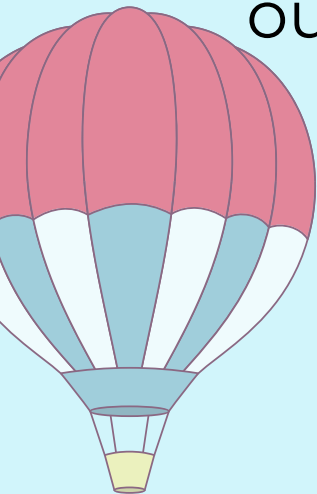
Toddler Time
