An active card is required for Baby Rhymes and Music and Motion.

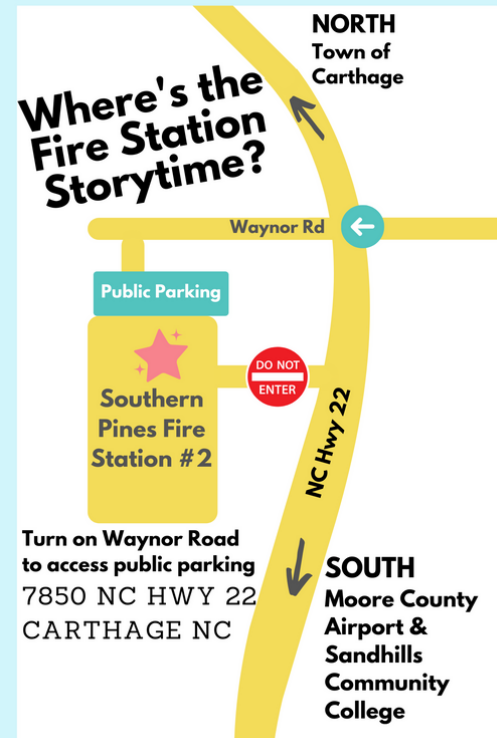
Baby Rhymes (birth-2 years) :
